NEW HOURS: Friday July 23, 12 to 8 pm; Saturday July 24, 10 am to 8 pm; Sunday July 25, 10 am to 4 pm.

Set up will start at 8:00 am Friday July 23. You may pick up your assigned space at the Gazebo in the park at that time. Personnel **will not** be available for set up other than the stated time.

All booths must be manned during festival hours. Failure to comply will result in application not being accepted for future festivals.

Food vendors may open earlier on Friday if desired. Rides may stay open until 10 pm Friday and Saturday.

PLEASE NOTE: In order to achieve our goal of providing a safe, family oriented weekend, we ask that the following not be displayed or sold:

- Toy or real: Knives -- Guns -- Swords -- Weapons of any kind
- Also, because of vendor and patron complaints we ask you not to handle:
- Silly String or Stink Bombs of any name or description.
- No items that promote drugs, tobacco or alcohol

Please observe the following Park Rules.

All vendors are responsible for cleaning up sites before leaving

Natural barriers, trees, bushes, benches or other park equipment must not be damaged or removed

By county ordinance, smoking is prohibited in the park.
